## EDITOR'S SOAPBOX Eraldo Pomare

I looked back to the February 2014 edition of the CARFF newsletter to see that the club budgeted \$3,500 for 2014 auction income; the numbers published in this newsletter show that we fell short of that target by almost \$1,150. That's equal to about 9 memberships. Speaking of memberships: the club budget is based on 56 paid memberships. We currently have 42 paid members, a shortfall of 14; so we would need to attract another 23 members for 2014 to balance this year's budget - otherwise we might well run a deficit in 2014. There's always the cost-cutting option, but growth is much healthier. Besides, the largest costs are fixed: insurance and taxes.

If you're thinking "how can I help?": The answer is simple: support the Air Show in every way you can - get the message out there, get people enthused about the challenge of RC flying, attract new members!!

## Message from Don McGowan, Alberta Zone Director Regarding Scale Aerobatics

## Good Morning All

I am sending this email to the appointed contact person for all clubs in "A" Zone. The idea behind the proposed club challenge is to promote friendly competition by encouraging clubs to participate in low level aerobatic competitions based on the "basic" level of Scale Aerobatics competition. The idea is not to judge each person, but rather to promote participation, a challenge for members to improve their flying skills and above all to have fun. It is hoped that the end result will be better retention of our membership for individual clubs and MAAC itself. It will also, hopefully, convince non-MAAC members to join the organization. I am asking that each club contact person distribute the message to their entire membership so that everyone has a chance to participate. The prizes mentioned in the event description will be awarded to participating clubs(not individual members) on a draw basis, not on flying skill. If anyone has any questions, give me a call.

To see the documents supporting this event, go to the MAAC website - > Committees > Scale Aerobatics > Committee Documents > Articles. There you will see the event flyers and the "aresti" documents which are used by competitors in scale aerobatics and pattern flying so that the maneuver descriptions can be universal regardless of language.

For those clubs/groups that are not active in aerobatics, I suggest that you, perhaps with the assistant of the appropriate committee (sailplane, heli etc.)endeavour to create such a competition for your chosen discipline for the future. I will be happy to support such endeavours.
