A JET AFFAIR

About a year and a half ago I started an affair with electric ducted fan (EDF) jets: I bought a Sebart Models PNP foam Fiat G.91 jet. Initial take-off runs in stock form on our grass runways were unsuccessful. A "careful" application of a Visa card bought a

new 90mm fan/motor/ESC combination. The stock 90mm unit drew ~80A while the new unit pulls in excess of 100A on a fresh 5000Ah 6S pack, turning the fan at ~40,000 RPM.

Three out of four flights have ended with "flame-out" landings with repairable damage. This is probably because at >100A current draw the cut-off voltage is reached very quickly - less than 3 minutes. But I did have one great landing. Honest!



Everything in the electric circuit, including wires, gets hot. For the "techies" out there:

- Consider the two 9-inch battery-to-ESC wires: They alone dissipate an appliance lightbulb's worth of power (15W); never mind all the other stuff!
 - If you want to check the math: 10 gauge wire has a resistance of 1.018 ohm per 1000', so the total length of ~18" for the two battery wires carrying 100A loses (I²R) = 15 watts.

I've also had to trash a 5000 mAh, 6s pack by soaking it in salt water then piercing the foil. The pack was charged/toppedup a few time but never flown - it puffed up very badly over last winter and was considered a fire risk.





My dalliance with jets is almost over: turbines are too expensive for me and larger EDFs aren't that far behind. You can't beat a sailplane for energy management & conservation!! Then there are biplanes & round engines too. *Eraldo*

There is, unfortunately some bad news: all MAAC, hence CARFF members will have received the <u>Transport Canada Civil Aviation Safety Alert</u> regarding drone illegal operation near forest fires. I have noticed a trend in mass media reporting where there is little or no distinction between unlawfully operated drones & normal "model aircraft". This trend is disturbing because if the public and lawmakers do not draw a distinction between unlawful activity and the safe operation of RC models, our hobby might find itself over-regulated and hamstrung.

So, as MAAC & CARFF members, we need to be great ambassadors for our hobby, which we can do through our own individual behaviours:

- Remembering our models are miniature aircraft and operating them as such.
- Not operating even small park flyers where any RC flying is not permitted or discouraged.
- Operating our models courteously and safely at all time at our field avoid low approaches over the road, follow & obey club rules and be good neighbours.
- If we see unlawful operation of drones or models, call the authorities. We cannot turn a blind eye for the public's safety and our own interests.
