2014 OLD FARTS FUN FLY

Join us for the annual CARFF Old Farts Fun Fly on Saturday, Sept. 13 and Sunday, Sept. 14, starting each day at 9 AM. Fun fly events include spot landing, most loops in 1 minute, most touch and go's in 2 minutes, precision taxiing, egg drop, and more. Lunchtime BBQ each day at the on-site concession. Free camping available for the weekend (un-serviced). Prizes for each event and every flight enters you for the grand prize draw.

DOGFIGHT OVER BENALTO

Attend an old CARFF institution: "**Dogfight Over Benalto**", it is happening on **September 20 & 21** at Hillman Field. It is the Fall Radio Control Flying Event at the ranch. Airplanes, Helicopters, Gliders, of all shapes and sizes. Fly-em if you have-em, or just come at watch the miniatures run through their paces.

Driving: go South of Sylvan Lake on 781 to township road 380, then west 10 km and south half mile on the Sand Road.

Or west on Hwy 54 to 781 and west on 380 to the Sand road that is actually between range road 24 and 25 so you can call it RR 24A.

Flying in with full scale: in CFS under Benalto/Hillman's ident is CBH7, and freq is 123.2 within 5 miles from airstrip. Call your position and intentions and we will clear airspace for you. **2500' x 60'** grass, powerline on north end. Full scale will park at north end, R/C flying at the south end. We can transport you from your plane to R/C flying field.

Come Friday night for camping across the road from flying field. No camping services or hookups but most people are self-sufficient anyway. Use of the OUT HOUSE is FREE. Fireside banter and flying stories abound in the evening. Bring your harmonica, guitar, accordion and you never know, if it sounds good enough you might stimulate a campfire choir. Ya, right!!!

Bring rod and fish hooks. If the river is up you could hook onto something that might give a short fight. If the river is low, you can go wading. But regardless, lots of room to fly.

You will want to be there for the **Harvard Historical Aviation Society** final fundraiser for the year, the **BOUNCING BOMB Golf Ball Drop**. I won't tell you any more about it than it could provide you with gas money for the weekend. This one, weather permitting, will be done on the 20th from a real full scale airplane.
