Glider Weekend Eraldo Pomare

The glider weekend held this past weekend saw the best thermal conditions we have seen for years. At times, it seemed that the entire sky overhead the CARFF Bawtinheimer Field was a huge thermal with lift "everywhere"! Jon From "specked out" his foam Super Cub after cutting power at about 100 feet, Todd Shulba of Edmonton brought his foam Radian Pro down only because he got tired - he almost had to leave it up there for the afternoon.

Ka8b was destroyed during a late afternoon tow on Saturday when the wings folded after the line went slack and then snapped tight.

I flew my DG 505 and Ka8b (pictured) on aero tow. I also flew my Blaster 3 discus launched glider (DLG). There were 3 Magellans (Rene Weber, Ron Munro and mine), 3 Radian Pros (Todd Shulba, Wayne Hopp, Wayne Hutmacher), one Mystique (John Ferguson, pictured above) and Jean Belair's Minemoa. Jean lives in St Albert and has joined CARFF as a full paid up member! Jon From brought his Ka8b mentioned above, and his "not officially a sailplane" Super Cub. Several other members also flew power & electric planes during the weekend. I hope I didn't miss anyone.

Thanks to tug pilots John Ferguson and Jon From, and I suppose I should mention that I was towing Jon's glider when the towing incident took place. John Ferguson nearly rekitted the 1/4 scale Super Cub tow plane on a cross-wind take-off with my Ka8b on the rope. Nice save, John - I was so mesmerized by the tug's antics that for a short while I forgot to "fly the plane" - i.e. I was watching the tug instead of my sailplane Anyway, the tow went uneventfully after that and we released at normal height (~500ft AGL).

The club winch was not used as there was only one suitable sailplane and the owner had other planes to fly.

Thanks CARFF for a super event! Hope to see more and more sailplanes - if you haven't tried thermal soaring, the Parkzone Radian and Radian Pro electric assist gliders are both amazingly cheap for the performance they deliver. They sell for between \$200 (Radian PNP) and \$320 (Radian Pro BNF).

EDITOR'S SOAPBOX Eraldo Pomare

Those who were not present at the last club meeting may have heard there was an animated discussion regarding field and facility maintenance. The issues, as I see them, are summarized as follows:

- 1. All Club Members have a responsibility to contribute to the successful ongoing operation of the club. There are many jobs that need doing and not everyone needs to do every job.
- 2. The Executive has the accountability and responsibility of organizing Work Bees, the Auction, Field & Facilities Maintenance, Flight Training etc. The responsibility is usually delegated to volunteer coordinators who often end up doing the lion's share of the work because not all club members step-up (see item 1).
- 3. SAFETY is paramount:
 - a. Working alone is not recommended (nor is flying alone). I personally will not operate machinery or fly larger power models when alone at the field.
 - b. Training on Safe Operation of equipment is essential (especially for some of us "office types", but should apply to all).
