## EDITOR'S SOAPBOX

### Eraldo Pomare

Another successful CARFF year has flown by; many thanks to the CARFF Executive & volunteers for a great job keeping the club energized. Next year is shaping up to be another exciting one for CARFF. Our second airshow is scheduled for July, then from 2016 we plan to alternate years with the Red Deer Airshow. Good to see!

In my opinion, it's building season (and Indoor Flying). Your editor continues to buy kits on eBay and over the Christmas break I hope to start building a Messerschmidt Bf 110 kitted years ago by Flair Models of the UK. Two 10 size brushless motors electrically should fly this plane well since it was originally designed for two Speed 600s! Barbara suggests I use the build process as newsletter 'blog' - so that's the plan!

Safety awareness in our hobby has come a long way but we still need to make extra efforts to keep safety in the forefront of our minds. Only when we internalize safe practices will we eliminate incidents leading to harm. Some thoughts follow; and while writing, I realized I'm not squeaky clean! **Do you always:**

- Charge LiPo batteries outside the model, in a fireproof container or outside well away from combustibles? Never inside your car?
- Dispose of LiPos after piercing the foil under salt water and soaking for 24h?
- Dispose of NiCd, lead acid & NiMH batteries at a recycling station?
- Tie down your IC engined plane when starting?
- Range check your radio system - including your 2.4 GHz sets?
- Ensure a zero energy state for your electric models by disconnecting the batteries after each flight?
- Observe runway etiquette/rules - announce take-offs & landings, observe the traffic pattern?
- Adopt safe practices with modelling tools, adhesives?
- Wear safety glasses when cutting music wire, using a drill etc.?
- Wear an appropriate breathing mask when using volatile paints and dopes?
  - Activated carbon filter for most dopes & thinners?
  - Supplied air for Endura or other 2-pack polyurethane paints?
- Store combustibles appropriately (balsa, paints, fuel, foam)? Batteries contain a lot of energy - are your LiPos stored in a pile(s) under/near combustibles, or in a fireproof container away from paper and balsa?
- Never airbrush or spray volatile paints in your basement? Close thinners/acetone cans immediately after use & keep away from the furnace? Limit the quantities?
- Control balsa dust? i.e. is there lots of balsa dust floating around when you're building (breathing hazard, dust explosion hazard)?
