Amendments read by Wayne Hutmacher change date to set membership fees para., (f) to Annual General Meeting instead of "when setting annual budget". Seconded by Lorn Brooker. Amendment moved by Rene Weber Seconded by Gale McCoy that para.
  (e) be amended to five members in good standing from one member in good standing. Seconded Ron Ditchburn, carried, notice of motion voted on and carried.
- 2. Dust abatement, notice of motion to be seconded, open for discussion and voted on. Moved by Harvey Fodor seconded by Gale McCoy followed by open discussion. Amendment moved by Wayne Hutmacher that amount to be spent be up to \$900.00 seconded by Gale McCoy, amendment voted on and carried, notice of motion voted on and carried.
