

This is what was stolen out of my garage.

They took 3 high end helicopter kits competed with all hardware installed.

Please note that all of these heli's have 3 red MKS brand servos by the main rotor head and are very easy to see. They have 1 red and silver MKS servo in the tail boom.

I hope these descriptions and photos help out. (Note: Photos omitted in "Antenna" by editor)

#1. Goblin 700 Kyle Stacey Carbon Fiber Edition. 3 blade main rotor. 3 blade tail. green and black canopy. Green tail and black. Serial Number is SG709. You can find this serial number on the right side of the heli if looking foreword from the tail boom.

This helicopter only had two flights on it and is like new. There is one dent in the leading edge of one of the main rotor blades it got from me folding the blades back to store it. There is a serial number for this but I never ducumented it. I don't think anyone else in Calgary would have this edition yet.

#2. Goblin 700 competition. 2 blade main rotor. 2 blade tail. Green and black canopy. Green tail. Serial Number is 7GRY07. You can find this serial number on the right side of the heli if looking foreword from the tail boom.

This helicopter has about 120 flights on it. The canopy has a small chip on the right side of the canopy. I also have a black dot on the main root head and blade to match each blade the blade grips.

#3 Goblin 380. Green and blue canopy. Green tail. Serial Number is SG381. You can see the serial number lying flat behind the main rotor blades.

This helicopter has about 60 flights on it and is in perfect condition.
